For this analysis, we began by evaluating 23 tax relief companies and scoring them based on a number of criteria. We only evaluated companies that offered free consultations, had been in business for at least five years, and had no complaints filed with the FTC.

We then took a look at the types of services offered and evaluated the company's customer service. We analyzed customer reviews using various websites, taking into consideration any relevant certifications or accreditations. Finally, we asked about the company's pricing structure, minimum debt amounts, and any money-back guarantees.
